### **Leak Detection Solutions at Water, Sewerage & Waste**

For reduced costs through accurate water leak detection, the latest range of Seba water leak correlators and ground microphones are being demonstrated for the first time by Mans International at Water, Sewerage and Waste. Other products on show include the new Sensistor portable gas leak detectors and a new line of underground cable locators that ensure maximum efficiency in water utility operations.

Water leaks escaping under pressure create noise which travels in both directions along a pipe. The Correlux P1 digital correlator is designed to pinpoint the leak by comparing the signals from two sensors picking up this noise and then measure the associated distance. It is rugged, and easy to operate like other Seba products such as the high sensitivity HL4000 ground microphone with state-of-the-art microprocessing power, and HL4R acoustic leak pen: a miniature wireless device for rapid leak noise location at convenient access points.

The Sensistor gas leak detection system is easily portable and entirely electronic for minimal maintenance. The low concentration of tracer hydrogen gas used, has been granted Drinking Water Inspectorate approval making it the ideal alternative to pressure decay methods. As well as water pipes, leaks can be detected in pressurised telephone and pressurised high voltage cables, below concrete and marble floors, roads and pavements. This system will appeal to water authorities, telephone contractors and those responding to gas leak emergencies who need a rapid response solution.
